BAPTISM OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

When you confess faith in Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior, His Holy Spirit comes and indwells in your Spirit making it come alive and able to connect to God the Father. In addition to this indwelling, there is also an infilling. Our bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit. Just like the temple had three parts, human beings have three parts: Spirit, Soul, and Body. Asking God the Father to have Jesus His son baptize you in His Holy Spirit, is a gift our good Father will give you when you ask.

Luke 11:13: "If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!"

1) Revelation

You can't pray for what you don't have faith for. We get faith by hearing the word of the LORD. Here are some scriptures references related to Baptism of the Holy Spirit.

"But one who is more powerful than I will come, the straps of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire." – Luke 3:16

"I baptize you with water for repentance, but he who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire." - Matthew 3:11

"But you, beloved, building yourselves up in your most holy faith and praying in the Holy Spirit," - Jude 1:20

"Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words." - Romans 8:26

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." - Acts 1:8

"For John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now." - Acts 1:5

"And when they had prayed, the place in which they were gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and continued to speak the word of God with boldness." - Acts 4:31

"And when Paul had laid his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came on them, and they began speaking in tongues and prophesying." - Acts 19:6

2) Renounce

Close doors to the enemy. Forgive everyone and pray a blessing for them. *"But when you are praying, first forgive anyone you are holding a grudge against, so that your Father in heaven will forgive your sins, too."* -Mark 11:25

There are three things that primarily block someone from receiving every good gift from God: Fear, Control, and Unbelief.

Out loud and with conviction say, "I repent and renounce Fear, Control, and Unbelief in Jesus' name and I receive Jesus' forgiveness and blood which washes me clean."

3) Receive

Pray, "Praise you LORD! We ask you Father to have Jesus your Son, baptize this man of God now with His Holy Spirit. Fill up his soul and body completely with your presence, in Jesus' name, amen."

4) Release

Once you sense Holy Spirit's presence, you can lay hands on the person receiving. Now start praying in tongues. If the person is having trouble releasing tongues, ask them to start. Instruct them to open their mouth and start forming words, but don't think about it first.
